Yalisove of the Delaware Group Sierra Club of the granting of a permit to Keystone Cogeneration Systems by the Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control. The Appellants were represented by Robert Jacobs, Esquire of Jacobs & Crumplar. Keystone Cogeneration Systems was represented by W. Harding Drane, Esquire and Harold I. Salmons, Esquire of Potter Anderson & Corroon. The Secretary of the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control was represented by Keith A. Trostle, Deputy Attorney General. Marsha Kramarck, Deputy Attorney General, served as counsel to the Board.

The Board heard testimony and took evidence from all Appellants, Keystone Cogeneration Systems, Inc. and Members of the general public.

Following its deliberations, the Board was unable to reach a final decision by a vote of a majority of the Members of the Board, as required by 7 Del. C. sec. 7006.
