I (Appellant) decline, any further adjudication granted to me under *7 Del. C. § 6008 and 7 Del. Admin. C 100 105 § 2.0* code, for my motion (EAB Appeal No. 2017-10) and all subsequent due processes involving the DNREC Environmental Appeals Board (EAB) with respect to Secretary's Order (No. 2017-W-0014). As issued by the Secretary of the Delaware Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (Appellee) Order (No. 2017-W-0014) permits the installation and daily operation of an ocean outfall pipe, discharging municipal wastewater for the applicant Rehoboth Beach, Delaware,

The divisive gap between the legality of the Order (No. 2017-W-0014) as promulgated the current Secretary of DNREC, Shawn Garvin, and environmental justice as prescribed by the agency of your representation, Delaware's Department of Justice (DOJ) is insurmountable. It appears, in this case, that the state's legal standards respectful of human decency and subsequent community health (ocean), are eroded beyond repair.

Any continuance of this appeal, (EAB Appeal No. 2017-10) will not remedy the contestable legalities of the Secretary's order, nor properly address the historical domination of the DNREC EAB against any conservationist activism of Delaware's residents.
