START ACTION NOTICE

SAN # 2013-26

- 1. **Type of Action:** Revise Section 33.0, "Solvent Cleaning and Drying" of 7 DE Admin Code 1124, Control of Volatile Organic Compound Emissions.
- 2. **Purpose of Action:** To update the control requirements of Section 33.0 of 7 DE Admin. Code 1124 based on an Ozone Transport Commission (OTC) Model Rule. The proposal will reduce the volatile organic compound (VOC) content of solvents for cold (non-boiling) degreasers from 100% low-vapor pressure VOC to 25 g/l VOC for most cleaners (150 g/l in certain electronic operations). The proposal will also include exemptions for certain critical cleaning operations, such as the cleaning of aerospace components and narrow tubing. A VOC emissions reduction in Delaware of about one ton per day is anticipated as a result of this action.
- 3. **Statutory Basis:** 7 Del. C. Chapter 60, Environmental Control
- 4. **Likely Affected Public:** Delaware users of cold cleaners, which include industrial shops, motor vehicle repair facilities, etc.

5. Proposed Schedule of Activities:

Workshops	October 2013
Public Hearing:	January 2014
Effective Date:	March 2014

- 6. **Review Committee:** This action does not require a review committee as it is based upon a well-publicized OTC Model Rule that included significant stakeholder participation. Workshops (one per county) and a public hearing will provide adequate opportunity for public education, review and comment.
