

1. TYPE OF ACTION:

The adoption of amendments to Delaware's Universal Recycling Regulations.

2. PURPOSE OF ACTION:

The purpose of this action is to modify the Universal Recycling Regulations to help achieve the statutorily designated diversion goals by clarifying existing regulatory language, adding clarifying language, and correcting typographical and grammatical errors.

3. STATUTORY BASIS:

Amendments to Delaware's universal recycling regulations are proposed and amended in accordance with the provisions found at 7 *Del.C.* §6010(a).
