Dear Owner:

Pursuant to the State of Delaware "Regulations Governing the Control of Air Pollution", Regulation No. 2, Section 2, approval from the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) is hereby granted for the operation of the following Gasoline Delivery Vessel(s) serial-numbered, and equipped with a Vapor Recovery System as specified in the application dated November 13, 2007:

This Permit is issued subject to the following conditions:

1. The Gasoline Delivery Vessel shall be operated in such manner as to maintain vapor-tight integrity at all times. The Gasoline Delivery Vessel's Certification of vapor-tight integrity, stating the test date and testing facility, shall be displayed near the Department of Transportation Certification plates.
2. Representatives of the Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control may, at any reasonable time, inspect this delivery vessel.
3. Air contaminant emission levels shall not exceed those set-forth in the State of Delaware "Regulations Governing the Control of Air Pollution".
4. No person shall release or cause the release of any gasoline vapors to the atmosphere from any vapor-tight delivery vessel.
5. Any delivery vessel which fails to maintain vapor-tight integrity shall be taken out of service immediately until such time as repairs are completed and the delivery vessel recertified.

6. The owner or operator of a delivery vessel shall determine the vapor-tight integrity of the delivery vessel on an annual basis in accordance with Regulation No. 24, Section 27 of the "**Regulations Governing the Control of Air Pollution**".
7. The vapor recovery equipment on the delivery vessel shall be maintained in proper operating condition, and shall be in use during the loading and off-loading of gasoline.
8. This Permit shall be kept with the delivery vessel, and be available upon request.
9. Failure to comply with the provisions of this Permit shall be grounds for suspension or revocation.
