PUBLIC WORKSHOP NOTICE

Regulation No. 1138 - Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Source Categories

The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, Division of Air Quality (DAQ) will conduct two public workshops on planned revisions of two air toxics standards in 7 **Admin. Code** 1138, Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Source Categories. The purpose of these standards is to reduce the emissions of the hazardous air pollutants.

One standard, Section 6, is applicable to facilities that perform chromium electroplating or chromium anodizing processes in electrolytic tanks. The other standard, Section 10, is applicable facilities that perform electroplating processes, non-electroplating processes, and/or dry mechanical polishing of parts that use or emit compounds of cadmium, chromium, lead, manganese, and nickel. The plating and anodizing operations subject to Section 6 are excluded from Section 10.

DAQ's planned revisions to Sections 6 and 10 bring Delaware's air toxics regulatory program into closer alignment with the EPA's National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants under 40 CFR Part 63 Subparts N and WWWW, respectively.

Both of these standards could apply to any given plating or polishing facility, so DAQ will present information on Section 6 and then information on Section 10 during each workshop, instead of conducting separate workshops for each standard. Persons interested in either standard should arrive by the indicated starting time, as the planned revisions are expected to be non-controversial and the workshops may progress quickly.

The purpose of these public workshops is to educate the public and affected industry on the draft revisions to Sections 6 and 10 and to hear comments and recommendations to aid in the development of the formally proposed revisions to these Delaware's air toxics standards.
