I would like this letter to become part of the hearing record for DNREC's adoption of the newly expanded State Resource Areas and Natural Areas Maps with the following comments regarding such.

At the DNREC Public Workshop held in Georgetown last Wednesday, April 26, it was apparent that Title 7 Chapter 75 has been recently "reinterpreted" by the Department from only identifying land that will be permanently protected as per the definition of Title 7 Chapter 75, to one where the counties will be encouraged to regulate private property through their Land Use Plan."

Due to this reinterpretation, we ask that all private property be taken off the State Resource Areas and Natural Areas Maps unless it has been permanently protected as per the definition or is already in negotiations to be permanently protected.
