Re: Transfer of Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) from Exelon Generation Company, LLC  
to Philadelphia Regional Port Authority

Dear Ms. Magee:

This is in response to your recent request to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) to transfer 81 tpy of nitrogen oxide (NOx) Emission Reduction Credits (ERC) from Exelon Generation Company, LLC, Philadelphia County to Philadelphia Regional Port Authority for use towards Delaware River Main Channel Deepening Project, Pennsylvania.

On May 6, 2010, the Department approved your request to transfer 81 tpy of NOx ERCs from Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon) to Philadelphia Regional Port Authority and revised the ERC registry accordingly. These ERCs are now available for use by Philadelphia Regional Port Authority to fulfill the General Conformity requirements towards the Delaware River Main County Channel Deepening Project. Under 25 Pa. Code § 127.206(f), ERCs generated from a shutdown source expire for use as emission offsets 10 years after the date the source ceased emitting the ERC-generated emissions. These NOx ERCs, which were generated from the shutdown of sources, expire for use as emission offsets if the credits are not used prior to December 16, 2014.





Dear Mr. Cornew:

This is in response to your recent request to transfer 81 tpy of nitrogen oxide (NO<sub>x</sub>) Emission Reduction Credits (ERCs) from Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon), Philadelphia County to Philadelphia Regional Port Authority for use towards Delaware River Main Channel Deepening Project, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Exelon has created these 81 tpy of NO<sub>x</sub> ERCs from the shutdown of the Exelon's plant in Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania. On July 21, 2005, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) certified these ERCs and entered into the ERC Registry system.

On May 6, 2010, the Department approved your request to transfer 81 tpy of NO<sub>x</sub> ERCs to Philadelphia Regional Port Authority (PRPA) and revised the ERC registry System accordingly. Enclosed is the ERC registry information pertaining to the ERC transfer. Our record in the ERC registry system shows that Exelon has remaining 205.5 tpy of NO<sub>x</sub>, 412.2 tpy of sulfur oxides (SO<sub>x</sub>) and 22.3 tpy of particulate matter size less than 2.5 micron (PM 2.5) in the ERC registry system. Under 25 Pa. Code § 127.206(f), ERCs generated from a shutdown source expire for use as emission offsets 10 years after the date the source ceased emitting the ERC-generating emissions. These NO<sub>x</sub>, SO<sub>x</sub> and PM 2.5 ERCs which were generated from the shutdown of sources expire for use as emission offsets if the credits are not used in a permit prior to December 16, 2014.
