There were 21 members/visitors in attendance.

Tier II Manager- Shannon Splittorff from DNREC-EPCRA reported that the Tier II reporting process has started for the 2010 calendar year. There are still 20 outstanding reports from last year.

Incident Reports- Tim Cooper of SCEMS reported one DECON team activation in November 2009.

DEMA Updates- Maureen Murray from DEMA gave an update on the HMEP Grant process.

Decon Trailer Updates-Dave Mick, Co-Chairman of the Decon Trailer User's group and Tim Cooper, the Sussex County representative for the group, gave a joint report on the Sussex County Decon trailer's capabilities and it's current operational status.

DNREC-ARP Update-Jay Brabson reported on the status on the one year follow up report that was proposed by EPA as part of the requirement for Concentrated Animal Feed Operations (CAFOs) on ammonia release. At this time, there is no regulatory requirement to submit a one year written follow-up report. DNREC and the EPA developed a continuous release report form.
