

Facilities

The facilities at the St Jones Reserve house the Delaware National Estuarine Research Reserve offices, classroom space, research and teaching laboratories, conference rooms, a Coastal Training Center, dormitory rooms, and interpretive exhibits. It is a federally funded; state owned and operated environmental education, training and research facility.



1. **St Jones Center for Estuarine Studies** includes Reserve offices, classroom space, research and teaching laboratories, and interpretive exhibits.
2. **Dormitory Rooms** are available for overnight lodging of visiting researchers or educators.
3. **Coastal Training Center** (“The Barn”) has two conference rooms that can be combined into a larger auditorium that can accommodate up to 75 people.
4. **The Maintenance Shop**
5. **St. Jones Nature Trail** is two-mile trail featuring a boardwalk over the salt marsh.
6. **Native Plant Nursery**
7. **Parking**

A rental fee will be assessed and reinvested in the Reserve program and facilities for its use by educational, governmental, natural resource, and non-profit groups. The center is not available for private parties. Reservations will be scheduled on a first-come, first-serve basis.
