St. Jones Reserve component is about 3,750 acres in designated size, situated along 5.5 miles of medium-salinity tidal river at the lower end of the St. Jones River watershed, with the river discharging into Delaware Bay. The river continues upstream another 5 miles, flowing out of Silver Lake near downtown Dover. The total length of tidal St. Jones River is approximately 10.5 miles.

The St. Jones Reserve component contains 35 parcels of land held by 23 private landowners, the DNERR, and two other state agencies (the Division of Fish and Wildlife and the Division of Historical and Cultural Affairs).
