Dear Secretary O'Mara:

On behalf of the members of the Citizens' Advisory Board to the Cherry Island Landfill (CAB-CIL), I wanted to update you regarding our planned meeting schedule for 2011.

Over the past five years, the CAB-CIL has met on a quarterly basis with staff members from DNREC and DSWA to receive updates regarding the expansion project at the Cherry Island landfill. These meetings are required by the project permit that was issued to DSWA by DNREC, as well as being called for in the charter of the CAB-CIL.

Based on the status of the project and the continued positive working relationship between DSWA, DNREC and the CAB-CIL, coupled with the minimal problems or concerns of the board, we plan to reduce our annual meetings for 2011 and beyond from four to three, conducting them every four months. In order to change our meeting schedule, we support the amendment to the project permit and plan to amend our charter to allow for the schedule change.

The CAB-CIL respectfully requests that you authorize the permit amendment to reflect the reduction of CAB-CIL meetings from four to three times per year, beginning in 2011.

A copy of this letter has been provided to DSWA, so that the authority may initiate a permit modification.
