

Natural Minor Permit Fee Comparison

- Found Natural Minor Fees for 34 State and Local Agencies
 - 1 (Virginia) does not charge for natural minor construction permits
 - 3 charge a simple base fee
 - Allegheny County - \$375
 - North Carolina - \$50
 - Montana - \$500
 - 3 States and Locals charge less than Delaware
 - Allegheny County
 - North Carolina
 - Virginia
 - 4 States and Locals seem comparable to Delaware
 - Arkansas
 - Maine
 - Maryland
 - Ohio
 - The rest of the States and Locals have complex strategies based upon cost recovery, the size of the facility, the type of equipment, or other criteria.

- The cost to permit a new 12 MMBTU/hr dual fuel (No. 6 fuel oil and natural gas) boiler was compared for Delaware, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, and Maryland
 - This is a natural minor source (NO_x PTE = 19.27 TPY, SO_x PTE = 55 TPY, CO PTE = 1.75 TPY)
 - This source is subject to NSPS Subpart Dc
 - Cost to permit in Delaware = \$330 (\$165 Advertising Fee + \$165 Construction Permit Fee)
 - Cost to permit in New Jersey = \$350-\$500 (General Permit: \$350 if filed on-line, \$500 if filed on paper)
 - Cost to permit in Pennsylvania = \$1,700 (NSPS Fee)
 - Cost to permit in Maryland = \$1,700 (\$200 base fee + \$1,500 NSPS fee)
