The Department has reviewed Claymont Steel's September 2007 submittal of the Slag Dust Fugitive Dust Emissions Control Study. This submittal reflects the discussions held with the Department and comments received at the public meeting on August 1, 2007. The noted implementation measures for the Scrap Yard, Slag Yard, Melt Shop, Ladle Slag Quenching, Coal Storage Station, and Roadways are deemed acceptable to the Department. Additionally, the ambient air monitoring locations are also found acceptable to the Department. The Department looks forward to the immediate installation and operation of the above mentioned ambient monitors. Please note that according to the Notice of Conciliation and Secretary's Order (Order No. 2006-A-0048) issued on October 23, 2006, paragraph 8, Claymont Steel shall submit a plan for implementation of the appropriate option, including an expedited implementation schedule for the Department's approval. The Department is committed to working with Claymont Steel to address community concerns and compliance issues surrounding facility operations and the fugitive dust emissions which continue to impact the nearby community.
