

Key Definitions

Area source is any stationary source or group of stationary sources located within a contiguous area and under common control that does not emit nor have the potential to emit considering controls, in the aggregate, 10 tons per year or more of any hazardous air pollutant (HAP) or 25 tons per year or more of any combination of hazardous air pollutants (HAPs).

Hazardous air pollutants (HAPs) are any air pollutant listed in or pursuant to Section 112(b) of the Act. HAPs are also called air toxics. Polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs) are a subset of a larger group of chemical call “polycyclic organic matter” or POMs. POMs are listed in Section 112(b).

New affected source is any asphalt processing operation or asphalt roofing products manufacturing operation that commenced construction after July 9, 2009.

Existing affected source is any asphalt processing operation or asphalt roofing products manufacturing operation that commenced construction on or prior to July 9, 2009.

Deviation is any instance in which an affected source or an owner or operator of an affected source fails to meet a requirement or obligation established in Section 16 of Regulation 1138.
