The Brownfields Development Program encourages the cleanup and redevelopment of vacant, abandoned or underutilized properties, which may be contaminated. A party seeking to develop such a property negotiates with SIRS for a **Brownfields Development Agreement (BDA)** to perform an investigation and, if necessary, a remedial action or remedy, for the purpose of addressing the risks posed by past releases of hazardous substances at these sites. However, a BDA is only available to parties that are not current site owners. The **Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) Agreement** is available to site owners, who want to clean up their sites and are

NPDES Permit

Notice is hereby given that the comment period has been extended 30 days for the Delaware City Refining Corporation, LLC (DCRC) National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit reissuance. The Delaware City Refinery, located on Wrangle Hill Road in Delaware City, to discharge cooling water, treated process wastewater, and storm water to Cedar Creek, the Delaware River, Dragon Run Creek and Red Lion Creek (NPDES Permit DE 0000256 and State
