The Department invites public comment on a proposal to clean-up the PB Wilmington RF 228 Site located in Wilmington. The approximately 0.35 acre southern portion of the Site was once used for automobile storage for a larger junkyard/auto salvage yard and has operated as an access road to other commercial properties since 1962. Exposure to soil does not pose as unacceptable risk to the proposed site uses. The site is currently located within the City of Wilmington Groundwater Management Zone (GMZ), and there are no current receptors for groundwater ingestion. The requirements of the Proposed Plan of Remedial Action include a request for a Certification of Completion of Remedy within 60 days of the issuance of the Final Plan of Remedial Action, and all soil/material that will be imported to the Site, or exported from the Site shall be done in accordance with DNREC's Soil/Material Reuse Policy, and must be approved by DNREC prior to being placed on the site.

LEGAL NOTICE - NOTIFICATION OF NEGOTIATIONS CONCERNING A VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT FOR THE TRAILS AND PATHWAYS FOR GEORGETOWN-LEWES SITE (DE-1668)

Pursuant to the June 2000 amendment to the Hazardous Substance Cleanup Act (HSCA), 7 Del. C. § 9107 (a)(1), the Department of Natural Resources and

Environmental Control (DNREC) is required to issue a public notice announcing the onset of negotiations concerning Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) Agreements, as well as any voluntary settlement agreements requiring a remedy, between DNREC and potentially responsible parties. The amendment states that DNREC must provide “public notification within 20 days after entering into negotiations for a voluntary cleanup settlement agreement with any person that agrees to perform a remedy.” The Site Investigation and Restoration Section (SIRS), on behalf of DNREC, initiated the VCP in February 1995 in an effort to lessen the time and cost required in cleaning up contaminated sites by reducing litigation. VCP Agreements are available, upon application to DNREC, to potentially responsible parties or prospective purchasers who may be liable for the contamination of a property, but who wish to settle their liabilities with DNREC under HSCA. DNREC is negotiating a VCP Agreement with State of Delaware’s Department of Transportation regarding the Trails & Pathway for Georgetown-Lewes Site (Site) located at Savannah & Donovan Rd. in Lewes, Delaware. The approximate 5.86 acre Site is identified on the maps of Sussex County as tax parcel number 335-8.00-30.00. The Site may have had a release of hazardous substances as a result of past use as a landfill. The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) has scheduled a public informational meeting for Thursday, December 7, beginning at 6:00 p.m. at the Five Points Fire Hall Company located at 209 S. Maryland Avenue in Wilmington, Delaware 19804. The meeting is being conducted in order to provide information to the public regarding proposed development plans for the Former GM Wilmington Assembly Plant Site. On October 12, DNREC provided public notice that it had entered into a Brownfield Development Agreement with Boxwood Industrial Park, LLC and advised the public of a twenty day comment period during which written comments would be accepted relating to the proposed development of the Site. During the written comment period, DNREC received a “Formal Request for a Public Hearing regarding: Brownfields Development Agreement for the General Motors Corp.” Pursuant to 7 Del. C. § 9126(c), “Upon receiving a request following the entry of the Department into a Brownfields Development Agreement, the Secretary shall conduct a public meeting to provide the public information regarding the proposed project, in or near the area where the facility is located.” Accordingly, DNREC has scheduled a public meeting on **December 7**, at the above referenced location to provide information to the public regarding the proposed development plans for the Site. The Brownfields Development Program encourages the cleanup and redevelopment of vacant, abandoned, or underutilized properties, which may be contaminated. A party seeking to develop such a property negotiates with SIRS for a **Brownfields Development Agreement (BDA)** to perform an investigation and, if necessary, a remedial action or remedy, for the purpose of addressing the risks posed by past releases of hazardous substances at these sites. However, a BDA is only available to parties that are not current site owners. The **Voluntary Cleanup**

Program (VCP) Agreement is available to site owners who want to clean up their sites and are already liable as a potentially responsible party for the site.
