Minutes:

Mark Prettyman (DAQ), along with a co-worker Bob Clausen (DAQ), began the workshop at 6:10pm after the arrival of only one attendee. Mr. Prettyman opened with a presentation to discuss the planned amendments to the stationary generator regulation, Regulation No. 1144. Mr. Prettyman started with a brief history of the development of the regulation, along with a summary of the requirements of the current regulation. Mr. Prettyman then discussed the various planned amendments to the regulation, by each section. Mr. Prettyman completed his presentation, and opened the floor for questions from the attendee. Mr. Widom's primary concern and suggestion was regarding the planned addition of new reporting requirements for "demand response providers". Mr. Widom suggested that an area which should be looked into more thoroughly would be on whether the onus for reporting should be on the owners of the generators which are participating in demand response, or upon the demand response providers who are aggregating the generators into demand response programs. Similarly, Mr. Widom pondered whether the "demand response provider" could also be held liable for any non-compliance of the generator, in regards to any other requirements of the regulation. Mr. Widom also suggested that the Department look into the recent amendments made by the State of Maryland in regards to their stationary generator regulation, since they incorporated similar requirements into their regulation.

After an informative discussion with Mr. Widom, the workshop was adjourned at approximately 6:50pm.
