Dear Members of the SCR 28 (RGGI) Workgroup.

I have attached a paper in which I lay out the case for a 100% auction of emission allowances, a distribution of funds to energy efficiency, renewable energy, public education, and assistance to the poor. In terms of how the money should be managed, I support the proposal that Nick will be making tomorrow - that 25% of the net funds (after administrative expenses) should go to the SEU and 75% should be managed by DNREC and controlled by a Citizens Energy Council.

Since tomorrow may be the last or next to last meeting of the Workgroup, I think it's important that the case for science, the environment, and publicly accountable fund management be made now.
