I would encourage the committee to add the additional option submitted yesterday by DE Audubon, Sierra Club and MALEC be included in the final report. Perhaps this can be edited down and distilled a bit.

For the record, The Nature Conservancy's position from the start has been a 100% auction with a majority of the funds used for energy efficiency and renewable energy program investments in Delaware. We have also encouraged 10% of the auction revenue planning and implementation strategies to respond to impacts of climate change, including funding of our forestland preservation program.
