AQM will then begin the next steps in the regulatory development process, to include holding a Public Workshop and a Public Hearing, using the third draft as the proposed distributed generation regulation. Please be prepared to discuss this path forward, for proposing and adopting the distributed generation regulation, at the upcoming meeting.

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
