During the 2 hour presentation there were clarifying questions posed by the group and considerable discussion on: allowance prices, leakage and energy efficiency, asset values of generators, the differing effects RGGI may have on existing generators (versus new capacity additions) and the impacts a Federal program might have.

At the conclusion of the ICF presentation, David Small reminded the group of the two questions before us and shared a draft bill for consideration at the next meeting.

Dr. Bryne noted that RGGI will not get us even to Kyoto limits, that it is a modest beginning and that choices need to be made about where to invest our resources.

Senator McDowell cautioned the group that any revenue impacts may be viewed in Legislative Hall as a tax and may be difficult to pass.

Phil Cherry furnished some handouts about Maryland's plans for auctioning allowances.

The group agreed that more studies were probably not needed and it was time to hash out our answers to the questions.

The next meeting date was then set for December 4, 2007 at 9:30 AM in the Wilmington area.
