

Key Definitions

Area source is any stationary source or group of stationary sources located within a contiguous area and under common control that does not emit nor have the potential to emit considering controls, in the aggregate, 10 tons per year nor more of any hazardous air pollutant (HAP) or 25 tons per year or more of any combination of hazardous air pollutants (HAPs).

Hazardous air pollutants (HAPs) are any air pollutant listed in or pursuant to Section 112(b) of the Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990. HAPs are also called air toxics. Chromium compounds and manganese compounds are listed in Section 112(b).

New affected source is any prepared feeds manufacturing operation that commenced construction after July 27, 2009.

Existing affected source is any prepared feeds manufacturing operation that commenced construction on or prior to July 27, 2009.

Deviation is any instance in which an affected source or an owner or operator of an affected source fails to meet a requirement or obligation established in Section 17 of Regulation 1138.
