### **PUBLIC WORKSHOP NOTICE**

#### **Regulation No. 1138 - Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Source Categories**

The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control, Division of Air Quality (DAQ) will conduct a public workshop on a planned adoption of a new air toxics standard into Regulation 1138. This adoption will impact any owners or operators of a prepared feeds manufacturing facility that use materials containing chromium or manganese compounds in the manufacture of animal feeds.

Congress sought to reduce cancer and non-cancer health risks due to the exposure to hazardous air pollutants (HAPs) in the 1990 Amendments to the Clean Air Act by mandating that the EPA 1) identify at least 30 HAPs emitted from area (i.e. small) sources that pose the greatest threat to public health, 2) identify categories of area sources that emit any of those 30 or more HAPs, and 3) promulgate area source standards to reduce the HAPs emissions and their associated health risks.

On July 19, 1999, the EPA publish its list of 33 HAPs (64 FR 38715); chromium and manganese were included in the list and on November 22, 2002, the EPA added an additional 23 area source categories, including “prepared feeds manufacturing” (67 FR 71428), bringing its final list to over 70 categories.

On January 5, 2010, the EPA promulgated the area source prepared feeds manufacturing standard under 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart DDDDDDD, to reduce the emissions of chromium and manganese.

DAQ’s planned adoption of new regulatory requirements into Regulation 1138 will bring Delaware’s air toxics regulatory program into closer alignment with the EPA’s National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants for area sources.

The purpose of this public workshop is to educate the public and affected industry on the draft regulatory requirements under Section 17 of Regulation 1138 and to hear comments and recommendations to aid in the development of the formally proposed Delaware air toxics standard.
