Re: RGGI Regulation Development Work Group/Stakeholders Meetings

Dear Ms. Kalisz:

On December 20, 2005, Governor Minner signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that made Delaware part of a multi-state Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI). The goal of RGGI is to stabilize and then reduce carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) emissions from fossil fuel-fired electricity generating units (EGUs), beginning January 1, 2009. Under the MOU Delaware is committed to propose for regulatory approval, its portion of a CO<sub>2</sub> Budget Trading Program. The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC) has now begun the development of this new Regulation.

To serve as the framework for this multi-state cap and trade program all of the MOU Signatory States, including Delaware, collectively developed a Model Rule. The RGGI Model Rule, along with other background information, is available at the RGGI website (see [www.rggi.org](http://www.rggi.org) ).

DNREC is establishing a review committee to aid in the tailoring of the RGGI Model Rule to Delaware. The review committee will be made up of DNREC personal, persons with environmental interests, and EGU owners and operators. You or your alternate is cordially invited to participate as a member of this committee.

At this time we anticipate holding of five committee meetings, one a month, between February and June 2008. The tentative dates and locations for each meeting are:


