The DNREC team has reviewed all the comments that were submitted and is now finishing up responses to those comments and polishing (albeit not quite burnishing) draft 5 of Regulation 1125. Considerable time was taken to get to this point and I believe we have come a long way toward defining a great FEL There will likely be more drafts before we are ready for prime time, but I hope to have a Public Workshop in June at the latest.

The agenda for the meeting is straight forward (1) clean up any old business, (2) review the comments and DNREC's responses and (3) take a look at draft 5 of rule 1125. I'm not planning on having any projection equipment available. If anyone needs such equipment for a presentation they may wish to make, please let me know to be sure (1) we have time available for such a presentation and (2) the equipment can be made available.
