### **LEGAL NOTICE**

#### **AMENDED PROPOSED PLAN OF REMEDIAL ACTION FOR THE SUNDAY BREAKFAST MISSION SITE (DE-1083) OPERABLE UNIT 2**

The Department invites public comment on a proposal to clean up the Sunday Breakfast Mission Site OU-2 located at 100 to 110 North Poplar Street in Wilmington. The 1.64 acre property (OU2- is approximately 1.24 acres) is the Mission's house for providing community assistance programs. OU-2 includes the main Mission building with its associated warehouse and parking areas.

The site soil is contaminated with phenols, PAHs, arsenic and lead. Phenols and petroleum compounds related to a leaking tank and former manufacturing operations have been detected in the groundwater.

The proposed cleanup includes removing the resin-impacted soils, monitoring the groundwater to assess remedy effectiveness, maintaining the current land use restrictions, restricting future intrusive activities and preparing a Long-Term Stewardship plan for the maintenance of the paved areas.
