Quarterly Consent Decree Report

Pursuant to paragraph 51.a of the Consent Decree, the following is the quarterly consent decree report submitted by Formosa Plastics Corporation, Delaware (FPC-DE).

i. Progress Report on the Implementation of the Supplemental Environmental Project:

The S2 reactor valve automation is complete. FPC-DE is currently evaluating various upgrades and/or modifications to enable the process computers to handle the new programming.

The E2 reactor portion of the project is complete with the exception of the reactor manway interlocks. The locking pins for the manway mechanisms were specially ordered and the first one has arrived for testing. We expect the remaining manways to be completed by 3/31/2008.


- ii. a. There were no individuals trained as stripping operators during the reporting period.
b. The layer of protection analysis has been completed and the report submitted.
c. There were no new quality control technicians trained in the lab.
d. The west aerator was returned to service on 12/7/2007.

iii. On December 20, 2007, FPC-DE experienced a deviation of Method 107 as four batch samples were not delivered to the lab in a timely fashion, as detailed in the letter submitted on 12/27/2007. FPC-DE is currently collecting duplicate samples and holding the duplicate until all required testing is complete.

iii. The twelve month rolling average RVCM data is attached.
