Weatherization Assistance Program 2013 Grant

The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC), Division of Energy and Climate, is applying for U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) 2013 program funds. The mission of WAP is to reduce energy loss and consumption in the homes of low income Delawareans, creating healthier and more comfortable homes while reducing energy bills. This application continues the work outlined in DNREC's previous Weatherization Program State Plans. The grant application requests approval to use \$452,837 in new Federal fiscal year 2013 funds recently awarded to Delaware.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The DNREC will hold a public hearing to consider comments from the public on our 2013 Base Weatherization Program grant application. Federal regulations require DNREC to provide opportunity for public comment on any new WAP grant.
