

Heavy-Duty Vehicle Rebate Program: Frequently Asked Questions

Q. My company is interested in purchasing a Compressed Natural Gas Vehicle. Where can I find a list of vehicles that qualify for this rebate?

A. For a list of vehicles available please visit [DOE Heavy Duty Vehicle Search tool](#). (Please note that vehicles listed in this search are of various classes. It will be the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that the vehicle purchased meets the requirements of the rebate program.)

Q. Are leased vehicles eligible for this rebate program?

A: Yes. Leased vehicles are eligible for this rebate. Lease agreements must be for three or more years with a vehicle leasing agency. A copy of the lease agreement must be provided to the Division of Energy and Climate at the time of the rebate.

Q. The vehicle I want to purchase is a CNG bi-fuel. Does this qualify under this rebate program?

A. No. The rebate only applies to vehicles that have a designated CNG engine.

Q. My vehicle has not come in yet and it is approaching 120 days since I received the commitment letter. What do I do?

A. Please fill out and submit the “120 day extension form,” which is found [here](#). In addition, please inform the Division of Energy and Climate as soon as possible. The Division can be reached by emailed DNREC.Transportation@state.de.us or by calling (302)735-3480.

Q. I lost the sales invoice showing my vehicle purchase; can I still apply for the rebate?

A. Applications cannot be accepted without all required supporting documents. The sales invoice for your vehicle is required as is the dealer signature. It is up to the applicant to ensure completeness of the application. All incomplete applications will be returned to the sender.

Q. I'm confused about the W-9 form... where do I find it and how do I fill it out?

A. In order for applicants to receive a rebate, the applicant **MUST** submit a W-9 form [ONLINE](#). Any W-9 forms submitted with an application will be shredded immediately. The link to the State of Delaware W-9 online page is <https://w9.accounting.delaware.gov/W9form.aspx> . Applications will not be processed without this documentation.

Rebates may be considered taxable income by the IRS. Please consult your tax professional.
