## **What Every Boater Needs to Know !**

The USCG Auxiliary will be presenting a **Boating Skills & Seamanship Course** starting on **Monday 22 February 2016**, at Short's Marine, in Millsboro, DE. The course consists of seven sessions from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. each Monday.

Boat handling, navigation aids and rules, required safety equipment, trailering, and numerous other topics important to the recreational boater will be presented and discussed by experienced and knowledgeable instructors.

**The Course satisfies all Federal and State training requirements for recreational boaters.** Students are awarded a certificate from the USCG Auxiliary, and a Safe Boating ID card from the State of Delaware upon successful completion of the course. **(Note: Persons born after January 1, 1978 must take an approved boating course in order to operate a boat in Delaware.)**

The cost is \$35.00 per student and includes an excellent textbook & all materials. The cost for students that own or can share their textbook is \$15.00.
