## Advanced Camp Requirements

- This is a **free camp** and lunches will be provided.
- Applicants **must** be between the ages of 12 and 15.
- Applicants **must** either **have attended the Basic Youth Academy** or **must possess a Hunter Safety course and Boater Safety course** certifications.
- Applicants **who attended the Natural Resources Police Basic Youth Academy** in 2018 must submit a 500-word essay explaining what they learned in the Academy. In addition, they must describe what they hope to learn in the Advanced Academy.
- Applicants **who have not attended a Natural Resources Police Basic Youth Academy** must submit an essay explaining what they learned in the hunter safety course and boater safety course, and what they hope to learn in the Advanced Academy.
- The course is **limited to the first 15 qualified applicants** and priority is given to those who completed the Basic Youth Academy in the previous year. Applicants who are not selected will be put on a waiting list in the order we receive the applications.
- Applications will be accepted through **Friday, June 7, 2019** for the Advanced Academy.
