



DELAWARE MASTER HUNTER CERTIFICATION



HOW TO BECOME A DELAWARE MASTER HUNTER:

1. Fill out and send in the application. You must be a Delaware resident, 21 years of age or older and have at least 3 years of licensed hunting experience. (Either [download the application](#) or tear the application out of the Delaware Hunting and Trapping Guide)
2. Take the one-day Delaware Master Hunter Core Conservation Course and successfully pass the test. You can find the next course date and sign up online.
3. Have successfully completed the Basic Hunter Education Course of Delaware or another state.
4. Complete at least one advanced hunter education course on bow or firearm with a shooting proficiency qualification.
5. Complete at least one other advanced hunter education course.
6. Have a Criminal Background Investigation completed showing a clean record.

When you have completed all six requirements and provided us with the above information, you must call the Hunter Education office at **302-735-3600** to confirm that your state credentials are correct, complete and in your Delaware Master Hunter file.

Delaware Master Hunter certification will be reviewed at the next meeting of the DMH committee. If approved, your records will be marked as **CERTIFIED**. A certificate will then be issued verifying your accomplishment and naming you as a **DELAWARE MASTER HUNTER**. You will also receive a Master Hunter hat and emblem.

Your contact information will be turned in to Delaware's deer biologist to be considered as a possible participant in future special regulation hunts. An annual update and proficiency qualification with your hunting firearm will be required for recommendation or participation in any state managed hunt.
