IMPORTANT: Due to COVID-19, the Division is implementing self-checking at all checking stations to encourage social distancing. Please use the self-check card inside the front of the mailbox. To complete registration of your turkey, fill out the card completely and to the best of your abilities. Remember to sign and date it. Then remove the bottom portion and deposit the top half in the slot in the back of the mailbox. The bottom portion is your receipt that you reported your harvest in case you are contacted by enforcement. If multiple people are using or waiting to use the self-check station, please remain at least 6 feet apart from one another or fill out the card at your vehicle using your own pen. Hunters who want to have their bird scored and entered into the National Wild Turkey Federation (NWTF) records are reminded to have their bird's weight recorded on a certified scale. Check stations will not be weighing birds this season. Please contact your local NWTF representative to have the turkey weighed.
