Applicant understands that completion of this form does not in any way secure them funding for the proposed restoration. Applications will be ranked by the Delaware Landowner Incentive Program Committee on a quarterly basis and the highest ranking individual projects will be funded. Once proposals are selected, landowners will enter into a legal agreement with DNREC Division of Fish and Wildlife that will determine the length of the contract, actions to be achieved and penalties imposed for a breach of contract. Contracts can either be 5 or 10 years in length. DELIP and Division Biologists will maintain long-term evaluation of all projects to insure success and landowner compliance. Any breach of contracts will require a refund of money paid according to the legal terms of each agreement.
