BACKGROUND

Every ten years, all US states and territories are required to publish a Wildlife Action Plan (WAP) in order to be eligible for important federal funding for conservation of non-game species. The first round of WAPs was done in 2005. It is a strategic document that provides guidance, coordination, and the best scientific information about how you can take action to conserve Delaware's important natural treasures. There is no regulatory component to the DE WAP. All participation is voluntary. Using the WAP can improve eligibility for participation in conservation programs and funding.
