


2013-2018 Delaware Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP)

Delaware's 2013-2018 Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP) summarizes the outdoor recreation preferences and anticipated facility needs generated by the recreating public. SCORP findings are essential in directing public outdoor facility investments that most closely match the public's stated needs. Furthermore, SCORP findings are helpful in guiding planning decisions related to parkland placement, outdoor recreation issues and planning for the public's preferred landscape types.
