

A few facts about Cultural/Historic Sites and Programming

- Over 40 identified archaeological sites
- Over 40 historic buildings
- Many farms and unique sites such as the Tri-State Mason-Dixon Survey Stone and the Newark China Clay Company Factory Site
- The Chambers House Nature Center was constructed by hand as a residence in 1820
- 25,000 total White Clay Creek State Park program participants for 2017
- 10,700 program participants based out of the Chambers House Nature Center, which can generally only accommodate groups of 25 people maximum
