


# White Clay Creek State Park



## A few facts about Natural Resource Ranking Levels I & II

- Natural Resource Ranking Criteria ranges from 1 to 5 based on the quality and importance of habitat with 1 being the best/most important
- White Clay has 97 rare species. A few examples include the long-tailed salamander, American redstart, spotted salamander, unicorn clubtail, barred owl, hooded warbler, mulberry wing, and margined madtom catfish
- Over 275 acres within the 100-year floodplain
- Top 4 problematic invasive plants: Japanese stilt grass, lesser celandine, Japanese barberry, and oriental bittersweet
- Over 2,159 acres are in Levels I and II, about 61% of the park
