

Recreation Concessionaires

- A wide variety of concessionaires exist within the Delaware State Parks system. A 'concessionaire' is an outside party having a recognized operation within the park. They typically operate under a mutually beneficial agreement, under certain terms, issued following an open bidding process.
- The Deerfield golf course and banquet facilities are owned by Delaware State Parks, but are operated and managed by Fourwinds Hospitality.
- The Silent Knight Soaring Society (SKSS) is another recreation concessionaire within White Clay Creek State Park. They support the flying of radio controlled model gliders and electric powered airplanes.
- The SKSS agreement with the Park was not a result of a bid process. It was an organization that used the area when that part of the Park was privately owned. As part of Delaware State Parks' acquisition of the property, the prior landowner requested that SKSS use continue.
- Omnia Humanitas operates the Kranz Hill Farm as another concessionaire on a portion of the Kranz Farm area of the Park. They offer a Community Supported Agriculture program and educational programs to reacquaint people with the land and farming.
- Several underutilized buildings within the Park may be future concessionaire opportunities
