Following receipt of comments on the first working draft of the revisions to the Delaware Sediment and Stormwater Regulations, the six subcommittees of the Regulatory Advisory Committee, Planning and Land Use, Policies and Procedures, Economic Impacts, Technical, Maintenance, and Urban Considerations, all met in the month of April to discuss comments made and establish a path forward for the individual subcommittees. The US Army Corps of Engineers recently released an updated version of its Hydrologic Modeling System (HEC-HMS) software. This latest version now incorporates the Delmarva Unit Hydrograph as a pre-defined runoff transformation function.
