1. **Training Dates & Locations Set for Revised Delaware Sediment & Stormwater Regulations**

The Department has set the dates and locations for training sessions targeted at individuals who will be preparing plans and engineering computations under the revised Delaware Sediment & Stormwater Regulations. The effective date of the revised regulations is January 1, 2014. During the first round of planned training, one session will be held in each of the three counties at the following locations on the dates indicated:

New Castle County: Grass Dale Center, Delaware City on **October 29, 2013**

Kent County: Delaware National Estuarine Research Reserve (DNERR), Dover on **November 6, 2013.**

Sussex County: Virden Center, UD Lewes Campus on **November 13, 2013.**

2. **2013 Blue Card Class Date: Last Class**

The last remaining date for the DNREC Contractor's Certification Course for 2013 is **December 11th**. The Contractor's Certification Course, also known as the "Blue Card Course", is a ½-day course that gives an overview of the Sediment and Stormwater Program, its regulations, and required erosion and sediment control measures in the State of Delaware. Under the Delaware Sediment & Stormwater Regulations, at least one person in responsible charge of a construction site must have successfully completed the Contractor's Certification Course. **Registration forms are available on the Sediment & Stormwater Program Web site under the "Certification Information" header:**

3. **2013 CCR Recertification Course Added: December 4, 2013**

The 2013 Certified Construction Reviewer (CCR) Recertification Course scheduled for **October 23, 2013** is now **FULL**. A second recertification course has been added on **December 4, 2013**. Eligible individuals should have been notified by the Department with additional information regarding registration.

4. 2014 CCR Course Dates: March 5, 12, 19 and 26

The 2014 Certified Construction Reviewer (CCR) Course dates have been set. The CCR Course will be held on four consecutive **Wednesdays, March 5, 12, 19 and 26, 2014**. All dates except for March 19, 2014 will be held at the Modern Maturity Center in Dover, Delaware, and are full days. The March 19 date is a mandatory half-day field trip to be held at locations to be determined closer to the date of the course. The CCR course cost is \$225 per person. Registration is required prior to the course.
