1. **Training Update for Revised Delaware Sediment & Stormwater Regulations**

The Department is now in the process of rolling out its training sessions targeted at individuals who will be preparing plans and engineering computations under the revised Delaware Sediment & Stormwater Regulations. The effective date of the revised regulations is January 1, 2014. The first round of training will be completed in all three counties as of November 13, 2013. Additional training sessions will be scheduled through 2014 with dates and locations to be determined. Information on these training sessions will be announced in future editions of this listserv.

The 2014 Certified Construction Reviewer (CCR) Course dates have been set. The CCR Course will be held on four consecutive **Wednesdays, March 5, 12, 19 and 26, 2014**. All dates except for March 19, 2014 will be held at the Modern Maturity Center in Dover, Delaware, and are full days. The March 19 date is a mandatory half-day field trip to be held at locations to be determined closer to the date of the course. The CCR course cost is \$225 per person. 4. **Link of the Month: DNREC Stormwater Assessment Study GIS Web App (beta)**

With the decommissioning of the Delaware DataMIL, the Department was left without one of the major tools proposed for use in preparing the Stormwater Assessment Study under the revised Sediment & Stormwater Regulations. The Department is pleased to announce that the DNREC Information Technology team, led by Debbie Sullivan, has developed a Web-based application to fill that void. The application is built on the ESRI Web GIS platform and is linked

directly to the Department's GIS data servers. When combined with the USGS StreamStats tool and the NRCS Web Soil Survey application, it is anticipated that SAS GIS application will be able to deliver the additional GIS information needed to complete the SAS. Although still considered to be in beta release and undergoing additional "tweaking", users can access the current version from the following link:
