#### 1. **Training for Revised Delaware Sediment & Stormwater Regulations**

**Level 1** training includes an overview of the following: changes to the regulations, technical document, Delaware Erosion and Sediment Control Handbook, post construction stormwater BMP standards and specifications, plan review process, DURMM v.2, and example site analysis. **Level 2** training includes hands-on use of the DURMMv2 compliance tool. You must attend Level 1 training prior to attending Level 2 training.

#### 3. **Remaining Blue Card Course Dates for 2014: September 10 & December 10**

DNREC Contractor's Certification Course for the remainder of 2014 has been scheduled for **September 10<sup>th</sup>** and **December 10<sup>th</sup>**. The Contractor's Certification Course, also known as the "Blue Card Course", is a ½-day course that gives an overview of the Sediment and Stormwater Program, its regulations, and required erosion and sediment control measures in the State of Delaware. ## **5. Link of the Month: Delaware Geospatial Data Exchange**

One of the questions that has come up on several occasions during the training sessions for the revised Sediment & Stormwater Regulations pertains to the availability of the source GIS data used in the Stormwater Assessment Study GIS app. In order to ensure data integrity, all publically available GIS data used by DNREC and other State agencies is hosted through the Delaware Geospatial Data Exchange. Once a user signs up for a free account, he/she then has access to these GIS layers as well as other spatial data.
