The Department is continuing the stakeholder and public input process in support of potential revisions to both the Delaware Sediment & Stormwater Regulations as well as the Technical Document. The Regulatory Advisory Committee (RAC) suggests changes to the Department on major issues, while various subcommittees focus on specific recommendations to address those issues. Upcoming RAC and subcommittee meetings have been scheduled as follows:

### 3. Blue Card Course Dates for 2016: May 26, September 15, December 8

The next DNREC Contractor's Certification Course will be held on **May 26<sup>th</sup>**. Two additional courses are scheduled for **September 15<sup>th</sup>** and **December 8<sup>th</sup>**. The Contractor's Certification Course, also known as the "Blue Card Course", is a ½-day course that gives an overview of the Sediment and Stormwater Program, its regulations, and required erosion and sediment control measures in the State of Delaware. Under the Delaware Sediment & Stormwater Regulations, at least one person in responsible charge of a construction site must have successfully completed the Contractor's Certification Course. **Registration forms are available on the Sediment & Stormwater Program website at the following link:**
