1. **Regulatory Advisory Committee Meeting: June 8, 2011**

The next Regulatory Advisory Committee (RAC) Meeting for the proposed revisions to the Delaware Sediment and Stormwater Regulations will meet on June 8, 2011 from 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM in the Felton-Farmington Room (DeLDOT Administration Building).

2. **Public Workshop: June 16, 2011**

The DNREC Sediment and Stormwater Program will be holding a public workshop to review planned revisions to the *Delaware Sediment and Stormwater Regulations*. The public workshop will be held on Thursday, June 16, 2011 at 6pm in the DNREC Auditorium, 89 Kings Highway, Dover, DE. It is not necessary to register to attend the workshop. 3. **Mark Your Calendar for CCR Re-Certification Class: November 3, 2011**

The Sediment and Stormwater Program will have a one day **Re-Certification** class for those CCRs whose certification is due for the 5-year renewal in the year 2011. Registration is required. The one-day Re-Certification class is scheduled for Thursday, November 3, 2011. Information packages will be sent out later this summer to those CCRs that are due for renewal. 4. **Link of the Month: EPA Draft Construction General Permit (CGP)**

EPA has released its draft Construction General Permit (CGP) for public review and comment. While this CGP only applies to jurisdictions in which EPA is the permitting authority for construction related activities, it is anticipated that the re-issuance of the CGP by delegated authorities (such as Delaware) will be expected to contain similar language. The Delaware CGP expired in February 2011, but has been administratively extended until its re-issuance. That process has already begun internally within DNREC.
