The goal for the revisions to the Sediment and Stormwater Regulations is to have a draft of the revised regulations by the end of CY08. Center for Watershed Protection (CWP) has teamed with Horsley Witten Group and JMT to provide consultant services to DNREC in preparing the revisions to the regulations. The CWP team will develop the technical info needed for DNREC and DNREC will bring that to the RAC.

Future subcommittees discussed include:

- Technical – hydraulics & hydrology
- Urban Considerations – redevelopment, infill, brownfield development
- Planning and Land Use
- Policies and Procedures – look at law’s support to regs; separate regs from policy
- Economic Impacts
- Maintenance

The next meeting of the RAC will be held Tuesday, January 22, 2008 at 10am in the Felton-Farmington Conference Room. Meetings of the RAC will then occur monthly on the fourth Tuesday of the month.
