

CONSTRUCTION IN STATE WETLANDS (TYPE I)

* Please make sure that all answers in this appendix correspond to information on the application drawings.

* Type I Permits are required for:

- A. Projects for which a total of one (1) acre or less of wetlands is involved, and no building of structures is included.
- B. The maintenance or repair of bridges, roads, highways, or the facilities of any municipality or public utility, including the construction and maintenance of lines for the transmission of electrical energy that do not require the construction of permanent access roads or other fixed works related thereto, and which will permit the unobstructed flow of the tide and preserve the natural contour of the wetlands. This provision shall not apply in emergencies; in which cases, written notification shall be made to the Division within seven (7) days after initiation.
- C. Maintenance dredging that does not result in deposit of spoils on wetlands.
- D. Maintenance work on existing wildlife management impoundments.
