Absolutely . . . NPDES Permit (which can be transferred from Pinnacle but will require numerous modifications and public notice), Construction Permit for the construction of the new WWTP at the facility, they will be required to have an approved Storm Water Pollution Protection Plan (no permit or fee on this), and an SPCC Plan (I don't believe there is a permit or fee required on this). I think they also mentioned something about putting in "leaching lagoons" ?? (if they are looking to put in some type of RIB system, they will need permits for that as well (Groundwater Section). I will be calling the folks at Allen Harim to get some additional info on what they mean by leaching lagoons.
