Question . . . since the proposed WWTP for the Millsboro site will be very similar to the WWTP you have in Cordova, would you be willing to share the nutrient data from the Cordova plant's NPDES discharge? We would like to use this data to get some idea of what the new plant's capabilities might be with the added ENR. We would be interested in the monthly average concentrations for TN and TP for the last couple of years if possible.
